CAMP SCHEDULE*:

Friday, Nov 13: Arrival and check-in for Camp 1 (pm).

Saturday, Nov 14: Morning free-skiing drills on SL skis, then brush and stubby courses. Afternoon video analysis, followed by chalk talk on “Slalom Tactics”.

Sunday, Nov 15: Morning SL training (stubbies, full gates). Afternoon video analysis followed by optional stretching, core, and agility session.

Monday, Nov 16: Morning SL training (full gates). Afternoon video analysis. Evening Zoom presentation by Mike Beers, SWIX USA: “Trends in ski waxing and tuning”.

Tuesday, Nov 17: Morning GS training. Afternoon video analysis, followed by chalk talk, “GS Tactics”.

Wednesday, Nov 18: Morning GS training. Departure after lunch for those only in Camp #1. Optional stretching, core-strength, and agility session for those staying for camp #2.

Thursday, Nov 19: No skiing. (Coaches’ day off.) **Arrival and check-in for Camp 2 (pm).**

Friday, Nov 20: Morning SL training (stubbies, full gates). Afternoon video analysis followed by chalk talk, “What you can learn from watching the World Cup”.

Saturday, Nov 21: Morning SL training (full gates). Afternoon video analysis, followed by optional stretching, core-strength, and agility session.

Sunday, Nov 22: Morning GS training. Evening Zoom presentation by Mike Beers, SWIX USA: “Trends in ski waxing and tuning”.

Monday, Nov 23: Morning GS training. Afternoon video analysis, followed by chalk talk, “Gear Trends for Masters Racers”.

Tuesday, Nov 24: Morning GS training. Departure after lunch.

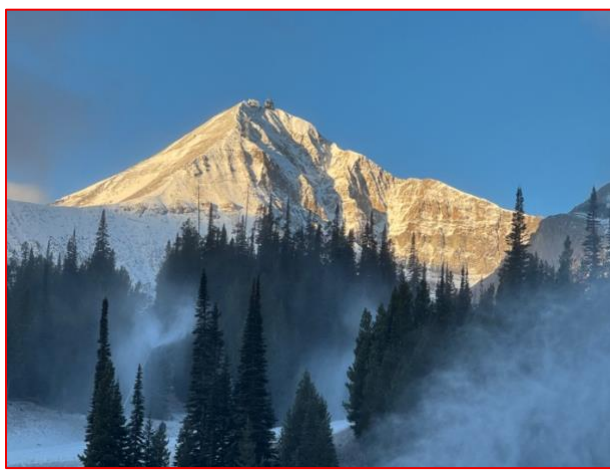


Huntley Lodge: Ski in/ski out.

PRICING:

Double Occupancy, Camp 1 or 2: \$2,620

Single Occupancy, Camp 1 or 2: \$3,080

Local's Special per Camp: \$1,700

Double Occupancy, Both Camps: \$5,601

Single Occupancy, Both Camps: \$6,578

Camp 1 or 2 includes 5 nights lodging starting on your arrival day, all meals starting with dinner on your arrival day through lunch after skiing on the last day of the camp, and 5 days lift tickets

Local's special includes everything on site except lunches only and no lodging. If you sign up for both camps as a local, lunch is not included on Nov 19, the day off between the camps.

Both Camps includes 10 days on snow (camps 1 and 2 combined), plus lodging and 3 meals but no skiing on Nov 19, the day off between the camps.

Note: Ground transportation from/to Bozeman airport (BZN) is not included. Rental cars and shuttles are available. Contact Camp Director Lisa Ballard if you need help arranging ground transportation.

CANCELATION POLICY:

If BSSEF cancels the camp for any reason, your camp fee is fully refundable, minus the credit card processing fee (3%) if you paid by credit card.

If YOU need to cancel for any reason prior to October 1, your camp fee is fully refundable, minus the 3% credit card fee processing fee if you paid by credit card. If you cancel on October 1 or later, your camp fee is refundable only if your spot is filled by another racer, less the 3% credit card fee.

SPECIAL NOTES:

Restaurants and bars on the mountain will not be open during the camp, as the resort is not open to the public yet, however the general store in The Exchange (base lodge) is usually open during normal business hours.

Because Big Sky is not open to the public, season's passes and IKON passes are not valid during the camp. Only athletes and coaches are allowed on the hill and only during assigned lane times.

At the request of Big Sky Resort and due to high demand, athletes must register for the entire camp. If you cannot participate in all days, there is no price break.
